Can children talk about old, new. Parent/Grandparents liked to do when they were younger? (Recapped from EYFS) Introduce/recap time line – divisions of 10 years. Introduce vocabulary Past, Present, Yesterday, Last week, Then, Before I was born, When my parents were born, Decades (time line split in 10s) Explain we are going to be learning about the history of Westcliff – local area. Explain Westcliff came before their parents – possibly before some of their Grandparents. Tasks Timeline - Order learning so far (those completed Humber Bridge – topic -Year 2s) born, parents born, grandparents born, Humber Bridge, Westcliff – 1960s. Leadership Explain that Westcliff as an area is part of a bigger area (county) and has a leader.....mayor of North Lincolnshire

How do we know about the history of Westcliff? Settlements Recap previous lesson. Chronology vocabulary. Ensure children can talk about the past and Westcliff as a place – local area. Explain Westcliff is a place in Scunthorpe – Scunthorpe town – history of Scunthorpe – it was made up of 5 villages. Pose the question How do we know about the history of Westcliff? Introduce the term historian - A historian is a person who specialises in the study of history, and who writes books and articles about it. Discuss sources of evidence, photos, maps, talking to grown-ups. Show map – outline area – children ask questions relating to history – question starters, When? Why? Tasks Overlay/compare maps and find out/learn the information Activity - memory markers – colours on maps – overlay – what has changed – old/recent.
