Year 3/4	- I can listen to and accurately repeat particular phonemes when learning vocabulary and within songs and rhymes. - I can understand sentences and questions made up of familiar language. - I can understand instructions, messages and dialogues within a sentence or short passage. - I can identify and note the main points and give a personal response to a story. <i>Spoken at near normal speed with no interference. May need short sections repeated.</i>	- I can have a short conversation where I can say 2-3 things. - I can use short phrases to give a personal response or to give an answer to a question. (May be repeated sentences with simple adaptations.) - I can attempt to use accurate pronunciation.	- I can read and understand some familiar words and phrases in written form. - I can identify and note the main points and give a personal response. - I can read independently.	- I can write some single words from memory. - I can begin to record in short phrases or sentences. <i>Spelling is readily understandable.</i>	- I can understand that nouns may have different genders. - I have a basic understanding of the order of words in taught sentences/subject areas.
Year 5/6	- I can understand simple passages and begin to understand longer passages made up of familiar language in simple sentences. - I can identify the main points and some details. - I can notice that the language may contain different phonemes and that some similar words may be spelt differently to English. <i>Spoken at near normal speed with no interference. May need some items to be repeated.</i>	- I can hold a simple conversation with at least 3 exchanges. - I can answer a range of questions on different topic areas using familiar sentences as models. - I can use mostly accurate pronunciation.	- I can understand a short story or factual text and note some of the main points. - I can use context to attempt to work out unfamiliar words.	- I can write a paragraph of about 2-3 simple sentences. - I can adapt and substitute individual words and set phrases. - I can use my vocabulary lists to check words I have learnt.	- I can use my knowledge of grammar to adapt and substitute single words and phrases. - I can recognise the main word classes eg, nouns, adjectives and verbs. - I can understand that adjectives may change form according to the noun they relate to and select the appropriate form. - I can recognise negative sentences.
